Nama means fresh, and this Sake was bottled immediately after processing to give it the best possible crispness.

Honjozo 300ml 16 -
Brewed with rice that is polished to 70% or less of the original size, it is the first level of the premium sake designation. Great for everyday enjoyment, it tends to be clean and smooth.

Stella Pinot Grigio	6 -	22 -
<i>Smooth, light, and refreshing, this popular Italian white wine is an elegant companion to salad and seafood.</i>		
Bonterra Chardonnay	7 -	26 -
<i>Produced from organically grown grapes, this well-rounded, complex wine is highlighted by citrus, apple, and pear notes.</i>		
Snoqualmie "Naked" Riesling	7 -	26 -
<i>Columbia Valley, Washington. This organic Riesling offers bright aromas of apricot and spice, with a hint of mineral carried through on the palate. The off-dry finish is clean and soft and the pure elegance of the varietal is fully captured.</i>		
Pomelo Sauvignon Blanc	7 -	26 -
<i>Lake County, California. Wonderfully fragrant, floral and grapefruit nose with fig and peach aromas.</i>		
L'Aumonier Sauvignon Blanc	7 -	26 -
<i>Touraine, France. This organic Loire Valley wine bursts with aromas of lime and citrus, while on the palate flavors include elderflower, rhubarb and citrus.</i>		
High Hook Pinot Blanc	7 -	26 -
<i>Willamette, Oregon. Locally owned by Mark Seymour from Leverett. Lively, yet sophisticated, this dry white wine exhibits aromas of green apples and lemon zest with hints of barrel spice.</i>		
Quivira Sauvignon Blanc		35 -
<i>Produced by a self-sustaining winery from the Dry Creek region of Northern California. Spicy notes add complexity unique to this wine's characteristic barrel-aging process.</i>		
Willamette Valley Pinot Gris		35 -
<i>Oregon. Bright, fruity, refreshing style with aromas of pear layered over a light citrus backbone and complemented by honeydew and green apple.</i>

<i>Jumilla, Spain. Organically grown with bright ruby-red hues and pleasantly intense and complex aromas of subtle black cherry fruit.</i>		
Our Daily Red	6 -	22 -
<i>An organic blend of Cabernet and Merlot that makes this wine fruity and flavorful.</i>		
Sierra Cantabria Tinto	7 -	26 -
<i>Fresh, silky and well-balanced, this classic Spanish wine is full-bodied with matured tannins. Compliments appetizers, vegetable dishes, and pasta.</i>		
Parducci Pinot Noir	7 -	26 -
<i>Mendocino, California. This sustainably-farmed Pinot Noir offers aromas of juicy ripe raspberries and strawberries. Its berry flavors are full and rich on the palate, picking up a hint of cedar in the finish.</i>		
Brunet Pinot Noir	7 -	26 -
<i>A medium-bodied wine from Southern France with notes of dark cherry and sweet oak.</i>		
Castello Monaci Piluna Primitivo	7 -	26 -
<i>Puglia, Italy. This 100% Primitivo has broad, ripe black fruit and spice aromas, with notes of pepper, toasty vanilla and a robust, concentrated character, a firm structure, and small black fruit and licorice notes on the finish.</i>		
Punto Final Malbec Reserva		35 -
<i>Mendoza, Argentina. Deep red in color with intense violet shades. On the nose, a combination of red fruits and toasty notes given by the French oak are evident. In the mouth the wine is complex and structured with a long aftertaste.</i>		
Textbook Cabernet Sauvignon		35 -
<i>Napa Valley. Textbook Vineyards crafts small lots of deeply-colored, richly aromatic and impeccably balanced Cabernet Sauvignon in Napa Valley's much heralded Oakville District.</i>		

Rosé

Valle Reale "Cerasuolo Rosato"	6 -	22 -
<i>Italy. Intense salmon-pink in color, with generous aromas of strawberry jam and wild herbs. Medium-bodied and fresh, with layers of fruit flavors and a lingering finish. Cerasuolo, means 'cherry red' in Italian.</i>
